10 Science] Center [at Dallas], the medical school at The University

11 of Texas Health Science Center at San Antonio, The University of

12 Texas Medical Branch at Galveston, the medical school at The

13 University of Texas at Austin, the medical school at The University

14 of Texas Rio Grande Valley, the medical education program of The

15 University of Texas Health Science Center at Tyler, the medical

16 school at the Texas Tech University Health Sciences Center, the

17 medical school at the Texas Tech University Health Sciences Center

18 at El Paso, the Baylor College of Medicine, the college of

19 osteopathic medicine at the University of North Texas Health

20 Science Center at Fort Worth, or the medical school at the Texas A&M

21 University <u>Health Science Center</u> [Medical Program].

22 SECTION 2. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives

23 a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as

24 provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this
