- 1 amended by this Act, applies only to an examination for a journeyman
- 2 lineman license administered on or after the effective date of this
- 3 Act. An examination for a journeyman lineman license administered
- 4 before that date is governed by the law in effect on the date the
- 5 examination was administered, and the former law is continued in
- 6 effect for that purpose.
