BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:

SECTION 1. Section 141.032, Local Government Code, amended to read as follows:

Sec. 141.032. LONGEVITY PAY. In a municipality with a population of 10,000 or more, each member of the fire or police department is entitled to receive, in addition to all other money paid for services rendered in the department, longevity pay of $\underline{\mathsf{at}}$ least \$4 a month for each year of service in the department $\frac{1}{100}$ exceed 25 years].

SECTION 2. This Act takes effect September 1, 2015.
