1-19 relating to longevity pay for peace officers and firefighters in
1-20 certain municipalities.

1-21 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:

1-22 SECTION 1. Section 141.032, Local Government Code, is
1-23 amended to read as follows:

1-24 Sec. 141.032. LONGEVITY PAY. In a municipality with a
1-25 population of 10,000 or more, each member of the fire or police
1-26 department is entitled to receive, in addition to all other money
1-27 paid for services rendered in the department, longevity pay of at
1-28 least \$4 a month for each year of service in the department [~~not to~~
1-29 ~~exceed 25 years~~].

1-30 SECTION 2. This Act takes effect September 1, 2015.
