- 4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- 5 SECTION 1. Subchapter C, Chapter 662, Government Code, is
- 6 amended by adding Section 662.061 to read as follows:
- 7 Sec. 662.061. NATIONAL DAY OF THE COWBOY. (a) The fourth
- 8 Saturday in July of each year is National Day of the Cowboy in
- 9 recognition of the historic, cultural, and social contributions of
- 10 the cowboy.
- 11 (b) National Day of the Cowboy shall be regularly observed
- 12 by appropriate ceremonies and activities.
- SECTION 2. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives
- 14 a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as
- 15 provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this
- 16 Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this
- 17 Act takes effect September 1, 2015.
