4	BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
5	SECTION 1. Subchapter C, Chapter 662, Government Code, is
6	amended by adding Section 662.061 to read as follows:
7	Sec. 662.061. NATIONAL DAY OF THE COWBOY. (a) The fourth
8	Saturday in July of each year is National Day of the Cowboy in
9	recognition of the historic, cultural, and social contributions of
10	the cowboy.
11	(b) National Day of the Cowboy shall be regularly observed
12	by appropriate ceremonies and activities.
13	SECTION 2. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives
14	a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as
15	provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this
16	Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this
17	Act takes effect September 1, 2015.
