8	SERVICES. The executive commissioner shall appoint for the
9	commission an associate commissioner for veterans services to:
10	(1) review programs and benefits available for
11	veterans;
12	(2) make recommendations on the improvement and
13	coordination of veterans services; and
14	(3) coordinate with other state agencies to enhance
15	veterans services.

SECTION 2. This Act takes effect September 1, 2015.
