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A BILL TO BE ENTITLED 1 AN ACT 2 relating to licensing and appointment of title insurance escrow officers; changing the limit applicable to a fee; authorizing a 3 4 fee. BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS: 5 SECTION 1. Sections 2652.001, 2652.002, and 2652.006, 6 Insurance Code, are amended to read as follows: 7 Sec. 2652.001. LICENSE AND BOND OR DEPOSIT REQUIRED. An 8 individual may not act as an escrow officer unless the individual: 9 (1) holds a license issued by the department; [and] 10 11 (2) is covered by [maintains] a surety bond or deposit 12 required under Subchapter C; and 13 (3) is appointed under Section 2652.1511 as an escrow 14 officer by a title insurance agent or direct operation. Sec. 2652.002. EMPLOYMENT OF ESCROW OFFICER. (a) A title 15 insurance agent or direct operation may not employ an individual as 16 an escrow officer unless the individual: 17 (1) holds a license issued by the department; 18 (2) is covered by [and maintains] a surety bond or 19 deposit as required under Subchapter C; and 20 21 (3) is appointed under Section 2652.1511 as an escrow 22 officer by the title insurance agent or direct operation [by this 23 chapter]. A title insurance agent or direct operation may not 24 (b)

permit an individual to act as an escrow officer in this state
 before the agent or direct operation has complied with Sections
 2652.151 and 2652.1511 [2652.152] with respect to the individual.

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Sec. 2652.006. RECORD OF ESCROW OFFICERS. The department shall maintain a record of the name and address of each escrow officer licensed by the department in a manner that ensures that the escrow officers employed <u>and appointed under Section 2652.1511</u> by any title insurance agent or direct operation in this state may be conveniently determined.

10 SECTION 2. Section 2652.051(a), Insurance Code, is amended 11 to read as follows:

(a) Before an initial license is issued to an individual to act as an escrow officer in this state for a title insurance agent or direct operation, the title insurance agent or direct operation must file an application for an escrow officer's license <u>and</u> <u>appointment under Section 2652.1511</u> with the department on forms provided by the department.

18 SECTION 3. Section 2652.052(b), Insurance Code, is amended 19 to read as follows:

(b) License fees, appointment fees, and renewal fees collected under this chapter [Section 2652.152], shall be deposited to the credit of the Texas Department of Insurance operating account to be used by the department to enforce this chapter and any other law of this state that regulates escrow officers for title insurance agents or direct operations.

26 SECTION 4. Sections 2652.055 and 2652.056, Insurance Code, 27 are amended to read as follows:

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Sec. 2652.055. LICENSE TERM. Unless a system of staggered license renewal is adopted <u>or required under Chapter 4003</u> [<u>under</u> <u>Section 4003.002</u>], a license expires on the second June 1 following the date of issuance.

5 Sec. 2652.056. <u>PROCEDURE FOR LICENSE RENEWAL</u>. An 6 individual may renew an unexpired escrow officer license by:

7 (1) submitting to the department on a form provided by 8 the department a completed application, signed and sworn by the 9 individual, stating that the applicant is an individual who is a 10 bona fide resident of this state or a state adjacent to this state; 11 and

12 (2) paying to the department a renewal fee in an amount 13 set by the department [AUTOMATIC TERMINATION OF LICENSE. The 14 license of each escrow officer employed by a title insurance agent 15 or direct operation that surrenders its license or has its license 16 revoked by the department is automatically terminated without 17 notice].

18 SECTION 5. Section 2652.101(a), Insurance Code, is amended 19 to read as follows:

(a) A title insurance agent or direct operation shall 20 obtain, at its own expense, a bond for its escrow officers appointed 21 under Section 2652.1511 payable to the department. The bond shall 22 obligate the principal and surety to pay for any pecuniary loss 23 24 sustained by the title insurance agent or direct operation through an act of fraud, dishonesty, forgery, theft, embezzlement, or 25 26 wilful misapplication by an escrow officer, either directly and alone or in conspiracy with another person. 27

SECTION 6. Section 2652.151(a), Insurance Code, is amended
to read as follows:

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(a) A title insurance agent or direct operation shall
certify to the department, not later than the expiration date of the
title insurance agent's or direct operation's license, the name and
address of each individual employed <u>and appointed under Section</u>
<u>2652.1511</u> by the title insurance agent or direct operation to serve
an escrow officer in this state.

9 SECTION 7. Subchapter D, Chapter 2652, Insurance Code, is 10 amended by adding Section 2652.1511 to read as follows:

Sec. 2652.1511. APPOINTMENT OF ESCROW OFFICER. (a) An escrow officer may be employed and appointed by more than one title insurance agent or direct operation.

14 (b) Before an escrow officer may act in that capacity for a 15 title insurance agent or direct operation, the title insurance 16 agent or direct operation must appoint the escrow officer and file 17 the escrow officer's appointment with the department on a form 18 provided by the department.

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(c) The appointment form must:

20 (1) be accompanied by a nonrefundable appointment fee;
21 (2) certify that the escrow officer is a bona fide
22 employee of a title insurance agent or direct operation with an
23 office in this state;

24 (3) be signed and sworn to by the title insurance agent
 25 or direct operation and by the escrow officer; and

26 (4) demonstrate that the escrow officer is covered by
27 a surety bond or deposit required under Subchapter C.

S.B. No. 1548 (d) The appointment of the escrow officer expires on the 1 revocation, termination, or nonrenewal of the escrow officer's 2 license or termination of the escrow officer's employment with the 3 title insurance agent or direct operation that made the 4 5 appointment. 6 SECTION 8. Section 2652.153, Insurance Code, is amended to read as follows: 7 Sec. 2652.153. NOTICE OF TERMINATION. 8 A title insurance agent or direct operation that terminates the employment of a 9 licensed escrow officer shall: 10 immediately notify the department in writing of 11 (1)the termination and request cancellation of the appointment under 12 Section 2652.1511 [license]; and 13 notify the escrow officer of the action by the 14 (2) 15 title insurance agent or direct operation. 16 SECTION 9. Sections 2652.203(a) and (d), Insurance Code, 17 are amended to read as follows: The department shall notify a license holder of a 18 (a) disciplinary action or enforcement action against the license 19 holder not later than the 30th business day after the date the 20 department assigns a file number to the action, except that this 21 subsection does not apply to a file or action: 22 (1) that is the subject of a pending criminal 23 24 investigation or prosecution; or 25 (2) about which the [deputy commissioner of the title 26 division of the] department makes a good faith determination that 27 there is a credible suspicion that there are ongoing or continuing

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1 acts of fraud by a person who is the subject of the action.

2 (d) The department may provide information about an 3 enforcement action, including a copy of a notice issued under this 4 section, to each title insurance agent or direct operation with 5 which an escrow officer has, or proposes to obtain, <u>an appointment</u> 6 <u>under Section 2652.1511 [employment]</u>.

7 SECTION 10. Sections 2652.057(b) and 2652.152, Insurance 8 Code, are repealed.

9 SECTION 11. The changes in law made by this Act apply only 10 to the issuance or renewal of the license of an escrow officer on or 11 after January 1, 2016. The issuance or renewal of a license before 12 January 1, 2016, is governed by the law as it existed immediately 13 before the effective date of this Act, and that law is continued in 14 effect for that purpose.

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SECTION 12. This Act takes effect September 1, 2015.
