5	SECTION 1. Subtitle C, Title 14, Occupations Code, is
6	amended by adding Chapter 2402 to read as follows:
7	CHAPTER 2402. TRANSPORTATION NETWORK COMPANIES
8	Sec. 2402.001. DEFINITIONS. In this chapter:
9	(1) "Department" means the Texas Department of
10	Licensing and Regulation.
11	(2) "Transportation network company" means an entity
12	that:
13	(A) uses a digital network or software
14	application service to connect passengers to transportation
15	network services provided by transportation network drivers;
16	(B) does not own, control, operate, or manage
17	vehicles used to provide transportation network services; and
18	(C) is not a taxicab or for-hire vehicle company.
19	(3) "Transportation network driver" means an
20	individual who:
21	(A) provides transportation network services
22	using a motor vehicle that is owned, leased, or otherwise
23	authorized for use by the individual; and
24	(B) is not a taxicab or for-hire vehicle driver.

- 1 (4) "Transportation network services" means 2 transportation of a passenger between points chosen by the passenger and prearranged with a transportation network driver 3 4 through the use of a transportation network company's digital network or software application. The term includes services 5 6 beginning from the acceptance of a request for transportation received through the transportation network company's digital 7 network or software application service and terminating when the 8 passenger exits the transportation network driver's vehicle. 9 Sec. 2402.002. LICENSE REQUIRED. A person may not operate a transportation network company in this state without obtaining and
- 10 11 maintaining a license issued by the department. 12
- 13 SECTION 2. This Act takes effect September 1, 2015.
