## A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

1 AN ACT

- 2 relating to the authority of the TexAmericas Center to incorporate
- 3 a nonprofit corporation for certain purposes and to the tax
- 4 treatment of such a nonprofit corporation.
- 5 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- 6 SECTION 1. Subchapter C, Chapter 3503, Special District
- 7 Local Laws Code, is amended by adding Section 3503.111 to read as
- 8 follows:
- 9 Sec. 3503.111. NONPROFIT CORPORATIONS. (a) The authority
- 10 may authorize by resolution the incorporation of a nonprofit
- 11 corporation under the Business Organizations Code to exercise the
- 12 powers granted to the authority. A corporation created under this
- 13 <u>section must be a nonmember, nonstock corporation.</u>
- 14 (b) Each nonprofit corporation created under this section
- 15 may:
- 16 <u>(1) acquire and hold title</u> to real property and
- improvements to that property; and
- 18 (2) collect and remit to the authority income, less
- 19 expenses, from that real property and from improvements to that
- 20 property.
- 21 (c) The board shall appoint the board of directors of each
- 22 nonprofit corporation created under this section. A board member
- 23 is not required to reside in the authority.
- 24 (d) A board member or employee of the authority may

- 1 simultaneously serve as a member of the board of directors of a
- 2 nonprofit corporation. A person serving as a board member of the
- 3 authority and of a nonprofit corporation created by the authority
- 4 may participate in all votes relating to the business of the
- 5 authority or the corporation, regardless of any statutory
- 6 prohibition.
- 7 SECTION 2. Section 3503.154, Special District Local Laws
- 8 Code, is amended to read as follows:
- 9 Sec. 3503.154. EXEMPTION FROM TAXATION. The property,
- 10 revenue, and income of the authority and of each nonprofit
- 11 corporation created under Section 3503.111 are exempt from all
- 12 taxes imposed by the state or a political subdivision of the state.
- 13 SECTION 3. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives
- 14 a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as
- 15 provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this
- 16 Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this
- 17 Act takes effect September 1, 2015.
