- 5 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- 6 SECTION 1. Subchapter B, Chapter 481, Health and Safety
- 7 Code, is amended by adding Section 481.038 to read as follows:
- 8 Sec. 481.038. SYNTHETIC CANNABINOID OR CATHINONE.
- 9 (a) Schedule I includes any synthetic cannabinoid or cathinone
- 10 designer drug that is not regulated by the United States Food and
- 11 Drug Administration or by the laws of this state but that is similar
- 12 by structure or pharmacological effect to a Schedule I or II
- 13 controlled substance that is regulated under federal law or the
- 14 laws of this state. In this subsection, "similar" means a substance
- 15 that contains one or more subunits in common with, or that mimics
- 16 the pharmacological effect of, a Schedule I or II controlled
- 17 substance.
- 18 (b) Any compound of a designer drug described by Subsection
- 19 (a) that is manufactured, formulated, sold, distributed, or
- 20 marketed with the intent to circumvent the law under this chapter or
- 21 <u>federal law is a Schedule I controlled substance.</u>
- 22 (c) Examples of synthetic cannabinoid designer drugs
- 23 <u>include substances that are generated using a three-component</u>
- 24 pharmacophore model. Synthetic cannabinoid designer drugs that

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- 1 contain one or more components of a controlled substance in
- 2 Schedule I or II under federal or state law are analogues of
- 3 Schedule I or II controlled substances.
- 4 (d) Nothing in this section affects an exemption provided
- 5 under state law to a person who possesses for a lawful purpose a
- 6 <u>chemical formula defined as a controlled substance.</u>
- 7 SECTION 2. This Act takes effect September 1, 2015.
