- 2 relating to the designation of certain customer bill payment
- 3 assistance program costs as an expense of operation that is a first
- 4 lien against revenue securing certain public securities or
- 5 obligations in certain municipalities.
- 6 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- 7 SECTION 1. Section 1502.056, Government Code, is amended by
- 8 adding Subsection (a-1) to read as follows:
- 9 <u>(a-1)</u> For a municipality in a county that contains an
- 10 international border and borders the Gulf of Mexico, the first lien
- 11 against the revenue of a municipally owned utility system that
- 12 secures the payment of public securities issued or obligations
- 13 <u>incurred under this chapter also applies to funding</u>, as a necessary
- 14 operations expense, for a bill payment assistance program for the
- 15 utility system's customers who:
- 16 (1) have received a notice of disconnection from
- 17 service for nonpayment of bills and who have been determined by the
- 18 municipality to be low-income customers;
- 19 (2) are military veterans who have significantly
- 20 <u>decreased</u> abilities to regulate their bodies' core temperatures
- 21 because of severe burns received in combat; or
- 22 (3) are elderly and low-income customers as determined
- 23 by the municipality.
- 24 SECTION 2. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives

- 1 a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as
- 2 provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this
- 3 Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this
- 4 Act takes effect September 1, 2015.
