4	BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
5	SECTION 1. Subchapter D, Chapter 5, Water Code, is amended
6	by adding Section 5.136 to read as follows:
7	Sec. 5.136. EXPEDITED PERMIT PROGRAM. (a) The commission

- 8 by rule shall create a program for the expedited issuance and
- 9 renewal of all permits issued by the commission other than permits
- 10 by rule, general permits, or standard permits.
- 11 (b) Rules adopted under this section shall:
- 12 (1) allow for public comments to be submitted only
- 13 <u>online;</u>
- 14 (2) require an applicant for an expedited permit or
- 15 permit renewal to pay a fee in an amount not more than twice the fee
- 16 required for a nonexpedited permit or permit renewal of the same
- 17 type; and
- 18 (3) require the commission to grant or deny an
- 19 expedited permit or permit renewal not later than the 60th day after
- 20 the date the permit or permit renewal application is received by the
- 21 <u>commission</u>.
- (c) The commission may waive the requirement in Subsection
- 23 (b)(3) on a majority vote of the commission after notice and a
- 24 public hearing as provided by commission rule.

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- 1 (d) If federal regulations prevent compliance with
- 2 Subsection (b)(3), the commission shall:
- 3 (1) clearly and publicly identify the relevant federal
- 4 regulation that prevents compliance; and
- 5 (2) if possible, apply for a waiver that would allow
- 6 <u>compliance.</u>
- 7 SECTION 2. The Texas Commission on Environmental Quality
- 8 shall adopt rules to establish an expedited permit program as
- 9 required by Section 5.136, Water Code, as added by this Act, as soon
- 10 as practicable after the effective date of this Act.
- 11 SECTION 3. This Act takes effect September 1, 2015.
