A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

1	AN ACT
2	relating to developing and maintaining risk assessment criteria for
3	use in determining whether an elderly or disabled person is in
4	imminent risk of abuse.
5	BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
6	SECTION 1. Subchapter E, Chapter 48, Human Resources Code,
7	is amended by adding Section 48.2055 to read as follows:
8	Sec. 48.2055. PILOT PROGRAM. (a) The department shall,
9	out of funds appropriated, implement a pilot program to evaluate
10	the feasibility and any associated benefits of providing protective
11	services when an elderly or disabled person has been determined to
12	be at risk of future harm from abuse, neglect, or exploitation using
13	the risk assessment criteria described in Section 48.004(a).
14	(b) Notwithstanding Section 48.002(a)(5), the provision of
15	protective services in an area in which a pilot program described by
16	subsection (a) has been implemented does not require that an
17	elderly or disabled person be in a state of abuse, neglect, or
18	exploitation.
19	(c) Notwithstanding Section 48.1523, the department is not
20	required to conduct a management review of recidivistic cases in an
21	area in which a pilot program described by subsection (a) has been
22	implemented.
23	SECTION 2. The department shall implement the pilot program

24 described in section 48.2055, Human Resources Code, not later than

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January 1, 2016. The pilot may be conducted up until August 31, 2017 1 2 but may terminate earlier if, in the discretion of the adult protective services program, it is appropriate for the program to 3 be terminated. DFPS shall submit a report of preliminary findings 4 from the program to the Governor, Lieutenant Governor, 5 and appropriate legislative committees having oversight over the Adult 6 7 Protective Services division not later than December 15, 2016 and on any additional findings not later than December 15, 2017. 8

9 SECTION 3. Section 48.2055, Human Resources Code, expires 10 August 31, 2017.

11 SECTION 4. EFFECTIVE DATE. This Act takes effect 12 immediately if it receives a vote of two-thirds of all the members 13 elected to each house, as provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas 14 Constitution. If this Act does not receive the vote necessary for 15 immediate effect, this Act takes effect September 1, 2015.

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
