A BILL TO BE ENTITLED 1 AN ACT 2 relating to the provision of affordable housing in colonias, rural communities, and small municipalities. 3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS: 4 ARTICLE 1. HOUSING IN COLONIAS, RURAL COMMUNITIES, AND SMALL 5 6 MUNICIPALITIES 7 SECTION 1.01. Sections 775.002(a) and (b), Government Code, are amended to read as follows: 8 9 (a) Contingent on the legislature's appropriation of sufficient funds, the Department of Agriculture shall [The governor 10 may] designate an office within the department to focus on matters 11 relating to colonias. The designated office shall [an agency to] 12 act as the state's colonia initiatives coordinator. 13 14 (b) The [If appointed under Subsection (a), the] colonia initiatives coordinator shall coordinate colonia initiatives 15 16 within the Department of Agriculture [agency] and with the other agencies and local officials involved in colonia projects in the 17 18 state. SECTION 1.02. Section 405.021, Government 19 Code, is transferred to Chapter 12, Agriculture Code, redesignated as 20 21 Section 12.050, Agriculture Code, and amended to read as follows: Sec. 12.050 22 [405.021]. REPORT ON STATE-FUNDED PROJECTS 23 SERVING COLONIAS. (a) In this section, "colonia" means a geographic area that: 24

S.B. No. 1670 (1) is an economically distressed area as defined by 2 Section 17.921, Water Code;

3 (2) is located in a county any part of which is within
4 62 miles of an international border; and

5 (3) consists of 11 or more dwellings that are located 6 in close proximity to each other in an area that may be described as 7 a community or neighborhood.

8 (b) Based on information provided under Subsections (c) and 9 (d), the <u>department</u> [secretary of state] shall establish and 10 maintain a classification system that allows the <u>department</u> 11 [secretary of state] to track the progress of state-funded projects 12 in providing water or wastewater services, paved roads, and other 13 assistance to colonias.

The department [secretary of state] shall compile 14 (C) 15 information received from offices within the department, the Texas Department of Rural Affairs, the Texas Water Development Board, the 16 17 Texas Transportation Commission, the Texas Department of Housing and Community Affairs, the Department of State Health Services, the 18 Texas Commission on Environmental Quality, the Health and Human 19 Services Commission, the Texas Cooperative Extension, councils of 20 governments, an institution of higher education that receives 21 funding from the state for projects that provide assistance to 22 colonias, and any other agency considered appropriate by the 23 24 <u>department</u> [secretary of state] for purposes of the classification 25 system.

26 (d) The <u>department</u> [secretary of state] shall compile 27 information on colonias that is received from the colonia

1 ombudspersons under Section 775.004.

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(e) The <u>department</u> [secretary of state] shall:

3 (1) with the assistance of the office of the attorney
4 general, prepare a report on the progress of state-funded projects
5 in providing water or wastewater services, paved roads, and other
6 assistance to colonias; and

7 (2) submit the report to the presiding officer of each8 house of the legislature not later than:

9 (A) December 1 of each even-numbered year, if 10 funds are appropriated specifically for the purpose of preparing 11 and submitting the report; or

(B) if funds are not appropriated as described by
Paragraph (A), December 1, 2010, and December 1 of every fourth year
following that date.

(f) The report to the legislature must include a list of colonias with the highest health risk to colonia residents, based on factors identified by the department [secretary of state].

18 (g) In conjunction with the establishment of the 19 classification system required by this section, the <u>department</u> 20 [secretary of state] shall establish and maintain a statewide 21 system for identifying colonias.

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(g-1) A system described by Subsection (g):

(1) must include a method for a municipality or
 county, on a form prescribed by the <u>department</u> [secretary of
 state], to nominate an area for identification as a colonia; and

26 (2) may provide for the review of a nominated area by27 the Texas Water Development Board, the office of the attorney

general, or any other appropriate state agency as determined by the
 department [secretary of state].

3 (h) The <u>department</u> [secretary of state] may contract with a 4 third party to develop the classification system or the 5 identification system or to compile or maintain the relevant 6 information required by this section.

If a colonia does not have a classification number, 9 10 the institution of higher education may contact the Department of Agriculture [secretary of state or the secretary of state's 11 representative] to obtain the classification number. On request 12 of the institution, the Department of Agriculture [secretary of 13 state or the secretary of state's representative] shall assign a 14 15 classification number to the colonia.

6 ARTICLE 3. REPEALER, TRANSITION, AND EFFECTIVE DATE

7 SECTION 3.01. Section 487.060, Government Code, is 8 repealed.

9 SECTION 3.02. As soon as practicable after the effective 10 date of this Act, the Department of Agriculture shall establish the 11 classification system required by Section 12.050(b), Agriculture 12 Code, as designated and amended by this Act. For purposes of this 13 section, the department may use an applicable classification system 14 already in effect.

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SECTION 3.03. This Act takes effect September 1, 2015.
