A BILL TO BE ENTITLED 1 AN ACT 2 relating to the membership of school district and open-enrollment 3 charter school concussion oversight teams. BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS: 4 SECTION 1. Section 38.151, Education Code, is amended by 5 adding Subdivision (2-a) and amending Subdivision (5) to read as 6 7 follows: (2-a) "Chiropractor" has the meaning assigned by 8 Section 201.001, Occupations Code. 9 (5) "Licensed health care professional" means 10 an advanced practice nurse, athletic trainer, 11 chiropractor, 12 neuropsychologist, or physician assistant, as those terms are 13 defined by this section. 14 SECTION 2. Section 38.154(a), Education Code, is amended to read as follows: 15 16 (a) Each concussion oversight team must include at least one physician and, to the greatest extent practicable, considering 17 factors including the population of the metropolitan statistical 18 area in which the school district or open-enrollment charter school 19 20 is located, district or charter school student enrollment, and the 21 availability of and access to licensed health care professionals in the district or charter school area, must also include one or more 22 23 of the following: 24 an athletic trainer;

(2) an advanced practice nurse;
(3) a neuropsychologist; [or]
(4) a physician assistant; or
(5) a chiropractor.

5 SECTION 3. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives 6 a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as 7 provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this 8 Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this 9 Act takes effect September 1, 2015.
