A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

AN ACT

relating to rules which insure that local independent school 2 3 district selection of non-state adopted instructional materials to be purchased with state funds, is as accountable and transparent as 4 the State Board of Education approval process for state-adopted 5 6 instruction materials.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:

SECTION 1. Section 31.003, Education Code, is amended by 8 designating the current rule as Subsection (a) and adding 9 Subsections (b), (b-1), (b-2), (b-3), (b-4), (b-5), and (b-6) 10 to read as follows: 11

(a) The State Board of Education may adopt rules, consistent 12 13 with this chapter, for the adoption, requisition, distribution, care, use, and disposal of instructional 14 15 materials.

(b) The state Board of Education may by rule set minimum 16 17 standards for local procedures selecting non-state adopted instructional materials to be purchased with state funds only 18 in the areas of: 19

(1)public notice, access, and input; 20 21 (2) review by independent panel to determine coverage 22 of the essential knowledge and skills;

(3) prevention/correction of factual errors; 23 24

(4) coverage of essential knowledge and skills in the

1	student version as well as in the teacher version of
2	instructional materials, pursuant to TEC 31.023(a);
3	(5) compliance with the stated purpose of TEC
4	28.002(h); and
5	(6) safeguards against corruption.
6	SECTION 2. This Act takes effect immediately if it
7	receives a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected
8	to each house, as provided by Section 39, Article III,
9	Texas Constitution. If this Act does not receive the
10	vote necessary for immediate effect, this Act takes
11	effect September 1, 2015.
