 1-20 counties for the provision of renewal and duplicate driver's
 1-21 license and other identification certificate services; authorizing
 1-22 a fee.

1-23 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:

1-24 SECTION 1. The heading to Section 521.008, Transportation
 1-25 Code, as added by Chapter 1233 (S.B. 1729), Acts of the 83rd
 1-26 Legislature, Regular Session, 2013, is amended to read as follows:

1-27 Sec. 521.008. ~~PILOT~~ PROGRAM REGARDING THE PROVISION OF
 1-28 RENEWAL AND DUPLICATE DRIVER'S LICENSE AND OTHER IDENTIFICATION
 1-29 CERTIFICATE SERVICES.

1-30 SECTION 2. Sections 521.008(a) and (a-1), Transportation
 1-31 Code, as added by Chapter 1233 (S.B. 1729), Acts of the 83rd
 1-32 Legislature, Regular Session, 2013, are amended to read as follows:

1-33 (a) The department may establish a ~~pilot~~ program for the
 1-34 provision of renewal and duplicate driver's license, election
 1-35 identification certificate, and personal identification
 1-36 certificate services in counties that enter into an agreement with
 1-37 the department under Subsection (a-1) ~~+~~

1-38 ~~[(1) not more than three counties with a population of~~
 1-39 ~~50,000 or less;~~

1-40 ~~[(2) not more than three counties with a population of~~
 1-41 ~~more than 50,000 but less than 1,000,001;~~

1-42 ~~[(3) not more than two counties with a population of~~
 1-43 ~~more than one million; and~~

1-44 ~~[(4) notwithstanding Subdivisions (1)-(3), any county~~
 1-45 ~~in which the department operates a driver's license office as a~~
 1-46 ~~scheduled or mobile office].~~

1-47 (a-1) Under the ~~pilot~~ program, the department may enter
 1-48 into an agreement with the commissioners court of a county to permit
 1-49 county employees to provide services at a county office relating to
 1-50 the issuance of renewal and duplicate driver's licenses, election
 1-51 identification certificates, and personal identification
 1-52 certificates, including:

1-53 (1) taking photographs;

1-54 (2) administering vision tests;

1-55 (3) updating a driver's license, election
 1-56 identification certificate, or personal identification certificate
 1-57 to change a name, address, or photograph;

1-58 (4) distributing and collecting information relating
 1-59 to donations under Section 521.401;

1-60 (5) collecting fees; and

1-61 (6) performing other basic ministerial functions and

2-1 tasks necessary to issue renewal and duplicate driver's licenses,
2-2 election identification certificates, and personal identification
2-3 certificates.

2-4 SECTION 3. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives
2-5 a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as
2-6 provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this
2-7 Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this
2-8 Act takes effect September 1, 2015.
