A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

1 AN ACT

- 2 relating to the provision of medical care to inmates confined by the
- 3 Texas Department of Criminal Justice.
- 4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- 5 SECTION 1. DEFINITION. In this Act, "department" means the
- 6 Texas Department of Criminal Justice.
- 7 SECTION 2. REQUEST FOR PROPOSALS. (a) The department
- 8 shall, not later than October 1, 2015, issue a request for proposals
- 9 to provide medical care to inmates confined by the department. The
- 10 department shall determine, and specify in the request, the region
- 11 of the state for which the medical care is to be provided. The
- 12 inmates for whom care will be provided must be at least 20,000 in
- 13 number but not more than 30,000, and must include a representative
- 14 sample of the physical and mental health and custody
- 15 classifications of inmates.
- 16 (b) A response to a request for proposals must be due not
- 17 later than the 180th day after the date the request for proposals is
- 18 issued by the department. An entity that on the effective date of
- 19 this Act contracts with the department to provide health care
- 20 services under Chapter 501, Government Code, may not respond to a
- 21 request for proposals under this Act.
- (c) A contract awarded in response to a request for
- 23 proposals must require that:
- 24 (1) the department not spend appropriated money to

- 1 make a payment under the contract without the prior approval of the
- 2 Legislative Budget Board; and
- 3 (2) the provision of medical care begin not later than
- 4 July 1, 2016.
- 5 SECTION 3. EXPIRATION. This Act expires January 1, 2019.
- 6 SECTION 4. EFFECTIVE DATE. This Act takes effect
- 7 immediately if it receives a vote of two-thirds of all the members
- 8 elected to each house, as provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas
- 9 Constitution. If this Act does not receive the vote necessary for
- 10 immediate effect, this Act takes effect September 1, 2015.
