## A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

1 AN ACT

- 2 relating to the period of days in which a student is enrolled in a
- 3 school in the United States for purposes of determining a number of
- 4 years for which the student may receive an alternative or exemption
- 5 from student assessment.
- 6 SECTION 1. Section 39.027(a-2), Education Code, is amended
- 7 to read as follows:
- 8 (a-2) Unless a student is enrolled in a school in the United
- 9 States for a period of at least 120 [60] consecutive days during a
- 10 year, the student may not be considered to be enrolled in a school
- 11 in the United States for that year for the purpose of determining a
- 12 number of years under Subsection (a)(1), (2), or (3).
- SECTION 2. This Act applies beginning with the 2015-2016
- 14 school year.
- 15 SECTION 3. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives
- 16 a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as
- 17 provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this
- 18 Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this
- 19 Act takes effect September 1, 2015.
