4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:

adding Subsection (a-2) to read as follows:

- 5 SECTION 1. Section 42.006, Education Code, is amended by
- 7 (a-2) The commissioner by rule shall require each school
- 8 district and open-enrollment charter school to report through the
- 9 Public Education Information Management System information
- 10 regarding the availability of school counselors at each campus. The
- 11 commissioner's rules shall require a district or school to report
- 12 the number of full-time equivalent school counselors providing
- 13 counseling services at a campus. For purposes of this subsection,
- 14 "full-time equivalent school counselor" means 40 hours of
- 15 <u>counseling services</u> a week. The agency shall maintain the
- 16 information provided in accordance with this subsection.
- 17 SECTION 2. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives
- 18 a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as
- 19 provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this
- 20 Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this
- 21 Act takes effect September 1, 2015.
