- 4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- 5 SECTION 1. Section 623.219(a), Transportation Code, is
- 6 amended to read as follows:
- 7 (a) For a permit issued by a port authority located in a
- 8 county that borders the United Mexican States, the commission
- 9 shall, with the consent of the port authority, designate the most
- 10 direct route from:

- 11 (1) the Gateway International Bridge or the Veterans
- 12 International Bridge at Los Tomates to the entrance of the Port of
- 13 Brownsville using State Highways 48 and 4 or United States Highways
- 14 77 and 83 or using United States Highway 77 and United States
- 15 Highway 83, East Loop Corridor, and State Highway 4; and
- 16 (2) the Free Trade International Bridge to the
- 17 entrance of:
- 18 <u>(A)</u> the Port of Brownsville using Farm-to-Market
- 19 Road 509, United States Highways 77 and 83, Farm-to-Market Road
- 20 511, State Highway 550, and East Loop (State Highway 32); or
- 21 (B) the Port of Harlingen using Farm-to-Market
- 22 Roads 509 and 106.
- 23 SECTION 2. This Act takes effect September 1, 2015.
