4	BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
5	SECTION 1. Section 154.053(a), Occupations Code, is amended
6	to read as follows:
7	(a) The board shall notify by personal delivery or certified
8	\underline{mail} a physician who is the subject of a complaint filed with the
9	board that a complaint has been filed and shall <u>provide</u> [notify] the
10	physician <u>with a full copy</u> [of the nature] of the complaint, without
11	redaction, and a statement of the alleged violation in plain
12	language [unless the notice would jeopardize an investigation].
13	SECTION 2. Section 154.0561, Occupations Code, is amended
14	by adding Subsections (e) and (f) to read as follows:
15	(e) The board shall deliver a copy of the preliminary and
16	final reports, including any dissenting or minority report, to the
17	physician who is the subject of the review.
18	(f) The name and medical credentials of each physician who
19	files an expert report shall be provided to the physician who is the
20	subject of the review.
21	SECTION 3. Not later than November 1, 2015, the Texas
22	Medical Board shall adopt the rules required to implement the
23	changes in law made by this Act.
24	SECTION 4. Sections 154.053 and 154.0561, Occupations Code,

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1 as amended by this Act, apply only to a complaint filed on or after 2 November 1, 2015. A complaint filed before that date is governed by 3 the law in effect on the date the complaint was filed, and the 4 former law is continued in effect for that purpose.

5 SECTION 5. This Act takes effect September 1, 2015.
