3	BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
4	SECTION 1. Section 361.101, Health and Safety Code, is
5	amended to read as follows:
6	Sec. 361.101. PROHIBITION ON PERMIT FOR FACILITY ON
7	RECHARGE ZONE OF <u>CERTAIN AQUIFERS</u> [SOLE SOURCE AQUIFER]. The
8	commission by rule shall prohibit the issuance of a permit for a new
9	hazardous waste landfill, municipal solid waste facility, land
10	treatment facility, surface impoundment, or waste pile, or areal
11	expansion of such a facility, if the facility is to be located on
12	the recharge zone <u>:</u>
13	(1) a sole source aquifer; or
14	(2) an aquifer that is:
15	(A) designated by the Texas Water Development
16	Board as a major aquifer; and
17	(B) a source of water for a municipality that:
18	(i) has a population of at least one
19	million; and
20	(ii) is located more than 100 miles from the
21	<u>Gulf of Mexico</u> .
22	SECTION 2. The changes in law made by this Act apply only to
23	an application for the issuance of a permit pending before the Texas
24	Commission on Environmental Quality on or after the effective date

1 of this Act. A permit issued before the effective date of this Act 2 is governed by the law in effect when the permit was issued, and the 3 former law is continued in effect for that purpose.

4 SECTION 3. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives 5 a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as 6 provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this 7 Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this 8 Act takes effect September 1, 2015.
