3	BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
4	SECTION 1. Section 437.351(d), Government Code, is amended
5	to read as follows:
6	(d) The legislature by concurrent resolution may direct the
7	governor to award the Texas Legislative Medal of Honor to a service
8	member nominated by the nominating committee. The committee chairs
9	serving on the nominating committee shall jointly prepare a
10	concurrent resolution directing the governor to award the medal to
11	a service member nominated. The legislature may direct the medal to
12	be awarded only during a regular session [and may not, during a
13	regular session, direct the medal to be awarded to more than:
14	[(1) one service member for service in the state or
15	federal military forces during the period beginning after 1835 but
16	before 1956; and
17	[ <del>(2) one service member for service in the state or</del>

- 18 federal military forces after 1955].
- SECTION 2. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this

Act takes effect September 1, 2015.
