A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

1 AN ACT 2 relating to participation in the state group benefits program by a member of the Texas National Guard called to protect the border. 3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS: 4 5 SECTION 1. Section 437.212, Government Code, is amended by adding Subsection (f-1) and amending Subsection (g) to read as 6 7 follows: (f-1) A member of the Texas National Guard who is not a 8 9 full-time or part-time state employee and who has been called to state active duty by the governor for the purpose of providing 10 border security is eligible to participate in the state group 11 benefits program under Chapter 1551, Insurance Code, and is 12 considered to be a full-time employee for the purpose of that 13 14 chapter, including the receipt of a full state contribution for insurance coverage. Notwithstanding Section 1551.1055, Insurance 15 16 Code, eligibility for a member of the Texas National Guard who elects to participate in the state group benefits program begins on 17 the first day of the month following the month in which the member 18

- is called to state active duty. An application for group benefit 19 20
- health insurance coverage under this subsection must be submitted
- in accordance with procedures established by the Employees 21
- Retirement System of Texas. 22
- 23 (g) The adjutant general and the Employees Retirement
- System of Texas shall coordinate and consult to implement the 24

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- 1 benefits program provided by <u>Subsections</u> [Subsection] (f) and (f-1)
- 2 and shall adopt a memorandum of understanding to establish:
- 3 (1) the procedures that a member of the Texas State
- 4 Guard or of the Texas National Guard may use to elect to participate
- 5 in the state group benefits program; and
- 6 (2) an appropriate method to annually confirm
- 7 continuing eligibility to participate in the group benefits
- 8 program.
- 9 SECTION 2. This Act takes effect September 1, 2015.
