4	BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
5	SECTION 1. Subchapter B, Chapter 2054, Government Code, is
6	amended by adding Section 2054.0286 to read as follows:
7	Sec. 2054.0286. STATEWIDE DATA COORDINATOR. (a) The board,
8	using existing funds, shall employ a statewide data coordinator to:
9	(1) improve the control and security of information
10	collected by state agencies;
11	(2) promote between state agencies the sharing of
12	information, including customer information; and
13	(3) reduce information collection costs incurred by
14	this state.
15	(b) The statewide data coordinator shall develop and
16	implement best practices among state agencies to:
17	(1) improve interagency information coordination;
18	(2) reduce duplicative information collection;
19	(3) increase accountability and ensure compliance
20	with statutes and rules requiring agencies to share information;
21	<u>and</u>
22	(4) improve information management and analysis to
23	increase information security, uncover fraud and waste, reduce
24	agency costs, improve agency operations, and verify compliance with

- 1 <u>applicable laws.</u>
- 2 (c) Each state agency shall cooperate with the statewide
- 3 data coordinator in fulfilling the requirements of this section.
- 4 (d) Notwithstanding Subsection (a), the board at its
- 5 discretion may eliminate the position of statewide data coordinator
- 6 <u>if the board determines that having an employee in that position no</u>
- 7 longer serves the purposes of this section.
- 8 SECTION 2. As soon as practicable after the effective date
- 9 of this Act, the governing board of the Department of Information
- 10 Resources shall employ a statewide data coordinator as required by
- 11 Section 2054.0286, Government Code, as added by this Act.
- 12 SECTION 3. This Act takes effect September 1, 2015.
