5	SECTION 1. Subchapter D, Chapter 172, Transportation Code,
6	is amended by adding Section 172.1571 to read as follows:
7	Sec. 172.1571. RESTORATION OF CERTAIN EXPIRED EMINENT
8	DOMAIN AUTHORITY. (a) This section applies only to a district:
9	(1) whose authority to exercise the power of eminent
10	domain under Section 172.157 expired under Section 2206.101(c),
11	Government Code; and
12	(2) that is located in a county:
13	(A) bordering the Gulf of Mexico; and
14	(B) adjacent to a county in which there is
15	located a port authority that has the authority to issue a permit
16	for the movement of oversize or overweight vehicles under
17	Subchapter O or P, Chapter 623.
18	(b) Notwithstanding the expiration of the district's
19	authority as described by Subsection (a), the district, on and
20	after September 1, 2015, may exercise the power of eminent domain in
21	accordance with Section 172.157.
22	SECTION 2. As provided by Section 17(c), Article I, Texas
23	Constitution, this Act takes effect only on a two-thirds vote of all

24 the members elected to each house.
