A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

AN ACT

1  
2 relating to excluding certain adult students receiving special  
3 education services from computation of completion rates for  
4 purposes of public school accountability.

5 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:

6 SECTION 1. Section 39.053, Education Code, is amended by  
7 adding Subsection (g-2) to read as follows:

8 (g-2) In computing completion rates under Subsection  
9 (c)(2), the commissioner shall exclude students who:

10 (1) are at least 18 years of age as of September 1 of  
11 the school year as reported for the fall semester Public Education  
12 Information Management System (PEIMS) submission and have  
13 satisfied the credit requirements for high school graduation;

14 (2) have not completed their individualized education  
15 program under 19 T.A.C. Section 89.1070(b)(2) and the Individuals  
16 with Disabilities Education Act (20 U.S.C. Section 1400 et seq.);  
17 and

18 (3) are enrolled and receiving individualized  
19 education program services.

20 SECTION 2. This Act applies beginning with the 2015-2016  
21 school year.

22 SECTION 3. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives  
23 a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as  
24 provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this

1 Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this

2 Act takes effect September 1, 2015.
