S.B. No. 1888

A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

1	AN ACT
2	relating to a requirement that a county report the number of certain
3	persons with mental illness detained in that county's jail.
4	BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
5	SECTION 1. Section 511.0101(a), Government Code, is amended
6	to read as follows:
7	(a) Each county shall submit to the commission on or before
8	the fifth day of each month a report containing the following
9	information:
10	(1) the number of prisoners confined in the county
11	jail on the first day of the month, classified on the basis of the
12	following categories:
13	(A) total prisoners;
14	(B) pretrial Class C misdemeanor offenders;
15	(C) pretrial Class A and B misdemeanor offenders;
16	(D) convicted misdemeanor offenders;
17	(E) felony offenders whose penalty has been
18	reduced to a misdemeanor;
19	(F) pretrial felony offenders;
20	(G) convicted felony offenders;
21	(H) prisoners detained on bench warrants;
22	(I) prisoners detained for parole violations;
23	(J) prisoners detained for federal officers;
24	(K) prisoners awaiting transfer to the

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1 institutional division of the Texas Department of Criminal Justice 2 following conviction of a felony or revocation of probation, 3 parole, or release on mandatory supervision and for whom paperwork 4 and processing required for transfer have been completed;

5 (L) prisoners detained after having been 6 transferred from another jail and for whom the commission has made a 7 payment under Subchapter F, Chapter 499[, Covernment Code];

8 (M) prisoners for whom an immigration detainer 9 has been issued by United States Immigration and Customs 10 Enforcement; and

(N) other prisoners;

12 (2) the total capacity of the county jail on the first13 day of the month;

14 (3) the total number of prisoners who were confined in 15 the county jail during the preceding month, based on a count 16 conducted on each day of that month, who were known or had been 17 determined to be pregnant;

(3-a) the total number of prisoners who were confined 18 in the county jail during the preceding month who were not charged 19 20 with a criminal offense and were apprehended by a peace officer: (A) for emergency detention without a warrant 21 under Section 573.001, Health and Safety Code; 22 23 (B) for emergency detention with a warrant issued under Section 573.012, Health and Safety Code; or 24 25 (C) for protective custody with an order issued under Section 574.022, Health and Safety Code; 26

27 (4) the total cost to the county during the preceding

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1 month of housing prisoners described by Subdivision (1)(M), 2 calculated based on the average daily cost of housing a prisoner in 3 the county jail; and

4 (5) certification by the reporting official that the 5 information in the report is accurate.

6 SECTION 2. This Act takes effect September 1, 2015.
