| 11 | that provide a comprehensive review for each end-of-course |
| 12 | assessment instrument listed in Section 39.023(c). |
| 13 | (b) From funds appropriated for purposes of this section, |
| 14 | the agency shall make the tutorials developed under Subsection (a) |
| 15 | available to public school students through the state virtual |
| 16 | school network under Chapter 30A. |
| 17 | (b-1) The agency shall provide the tutorials developed |
| 18 | under Subsection (a) through the state virtual school network not |
| 19 | later than the 2016-2017 school year. This subsection expires |
| 20 | September 1, 2017. |
| 21 | (c) A public school student may not be charged a fee for |
| 22 | access to a tutorial provided through the state virtual school |

1 <u>(d) The commissioner shall adopt rules as necessary to</u> 2 <u>administer this section.</u>

3 SECTION 2. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives 4 a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as 5 provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this 6 Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this 7 Act takes effect September 1, 2015.
