## A BILL TO BE ENTITLED AN ACT

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:

1-25 SECTION 1. Subchapter C, Chapter 29, Education Code, is 1-26 amended by adding Section 29.0845 to read as follows:
