5	SECTION 1. Section 815.402(a), Government Code is amended

8	period, each department or agency of the state shall cause to be
9	deducted from each member's compensation a contribution of:
10	(1) 8.0 [6.6 percent of the compensation if the member
11	is not a member of the legislature, for service rendered after
12	August 31, 2013, and before September 1, 2014;
13	[(2) 6.9 percent of the compensation if the member is
14	not a member of the legislature, for service rendered after August
15	31, 2014, and before September 1, 2015;
16	$[\frac{(3)}{7.2}]$ percent of the compensation if the member is not a
17	member of the legislature, for service rendered after August 31,
18	2015, and before September 1, 2017 [2016];
19	(2) [(4) 7.5 percent of the compensation if the member
20	is not a member of the legislature, for service rendered after
21	August 31, 2016;
22	$\left[\frac{(5)}{(5)}\right]$ for service by a member who is not a member of the
23	<u>legislature</u> rendered on or after September 1, 2017, the lesser of:

(A) 8.0 [7.5] percent of the member's annual

- 17 CONTRIBUTION. (a) Except as provided by Section 813.201, the board
- 18 of trustees shall assess each employer whose employees are members
- 19 of the retirement system a state retirement contribution in an
- 20 amount equal to 1.0 [0.5] percent of the employer's total payroll,
- 21 as determined by the General Appropriations Act.
