| 12 | speed limit established under the program may be displayed using a  |
| 13 | stationary or portable changeable message sign, as defined by       |
| 14 | Section 544.013. A speed limit that is established under the        |

| 16 | (1) must be based on an engineering and traffic                     |
| 17 | <pre>investigation;</pre>   |
| 18 | (2) may be effective for all or a designated portion of             |
| 19 | the highway and for any period of the day or night, as the          |
| 20 | department determines necessary; and                                |
| 21 | (3) is effective only when the speed limit is posted                |
| 22 | and only if a sign notifying motorists of the change in speed limit |
