- BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS: 4
- 5 SECTION 1. Section 521.044(a), Transportation Code,
- amended by Chapters 1012 (H.B. 2512) and 1105 (H.B. 3787), Acts of 6
- the 83rd Legislature, Regular Session, 2013, is reenacted and 7
- amended to read as follows: 8

- (a) Information provided on a driver's license or personal 9
- <u>identification certificate</u> application that relates 10 the
- applicant's social security number may be used only by 11
- 12 department or disclosed only to:
- 13 (1) the child support enforcement division of the
- 14 attorney general's office;
- 15 (2) another state entity responsible for enforcing the
- 16 payment of child support;
- 17 (3) the United States Selective Service System as
- provided by Section 521.147; 18
- 19 (4) the unclaimed property division of the
- 20 comptroller's office; [ex]
- 21 (5) the Health and Human Services Commission;
- 22 (6) $[\frac{(5)}{(5)}]$ the secretary of state for the purposes of
- 23 voter registration or the administration of elections; or
- 24 (7) an agency of another state responsible for issuing

- 1 driver's licenses or identification documents.
- 2 SECTION 2. Sections 521.044(b) and (e), Transportation
- 3 Code, are amended to read as follows:
- 4 (b) The department shall enter an applicant's social
- 5 security number in the department's electronic database but may not
- 6 print the number on the applicant's driver's license or personal
- 7 identification certificate.
- 8 (e) The department shall include in the department's
- 9 legislative appropriations requests and budgets, in quarterly
- 10 performance reports, and in audits of the department's local
- 11 offices performance measures on the percentage of complete and
- 12 correct social security numbers on driver's licenses and personal
- 13 identification certificates.
- 14 SECTION 3. Section 521.101(f), Transportation Code, is
- 15 amended to read as follows:
- 16 (f) A personal identification certificate:
- 17 (1) for an applicant who is a citizen, national, or
- 18 legal permanent resident of the United States or a refugee or asylee
- 19 lawfully admitted into the United States, [+
- [(A)] expires on a date specified by the
- 21 department [if the applicant is younger than 60 years of age; or
- 22 [(B) does not expire if the applicant is 60 years
- 23 of age or older]; or
- 24 (2) for an applicant not described by Subdivision (1),
- 25 expires on:
- 26 (A) the earlier of:
- (i) a date specified by the department; or

- 1 (ii) the expiration date of the applicant's
- 2 authorized stay in the United States; or
- 3 (B) the first anniversary of the date of
- 4 issuance, if there is no definite expiration date for the
- 5 applicant's authorized stay in the United States.
- 6 SECTION 4. Section 521.142(g), Transportation Code, is
- 7 amended to read as follows:
- 8 (g) The department $\frac{\text{shall}}{\text{shall}}$ [may] require an applicant to
- 9 provide the applicant's social security number or proof that the
- 10 applicant is not eligible for a social security number [only for a
- 11 purpose permitted by Section 521.044].
- 12 SECTION 5. Subchapter I, Chapter 521, Transportation Code,
- 13 is amended by adding Section 521.183 to read as follows:
- 14 Sec. 521.183. SURRENDER OF DRIVER'S LICENSE OR PERSONAL
- 15 IDENTIFICATION CERTIFICATE. (a) A person is not entitled to
- 16 receive a driver's license until the person surrenders to the
- 17 department each personal identification certificate in the
- 18 person's possession that was issued by this state.
- 19 (b) A person is not entitled to receive a personal
- 20 identification certificate until the person surrenders to the
- 21 department each driver's license in the person's possession that
- 22 was issued by this state.
- SECTION 6. The changes in law made by this Act apply only to
- 24 a driver's license or personal identification certificate for which
- 25 an application is submitted on or after the effective date of this
- 26 Act. A driver's license or personal identification certificate for
- 27 which an application was submitted before the effective date of

- 1 this Act is governed by the law as it existed immediately before the
- 2 effective date of this Act, and that law is continued in effect for
- 3 that purpose.
- 4 SECTION 7. To the extent of any conflict, this Act prevails
- 5 over another Act of the 84th Legislature, Regular Session, 2015,
- 6 relating to nonsubstantive additions to and corrections in enacted
- 7 codes.
- 8 SECTION 8. This Act takes effect September 1, 2015.
