## A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

AN ACT

2 relating to service credit and benefits under and funding 3 requirements for the Employees Retirement System of Texas.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:

5 SECTION 1. Section 813.101, Government Code, is amended to 6 read as follows:

Sec. 813.101. DETERMINATION OF REQUIRED DEPOSITS. 7 The retirement system shall determine in each case the amount of money 8 9 to be deposited by a member claiming credit for membership or military service previously canceled or not 10 previously established, or for any other service purchase. The system may not 11 provide benefits based on the claimed service until the determined 12 amount has been fully paid. 13

14 SECTION 2. Subchapter A, Chapter 814, Government Code, is 15 amended by adding Section 814.0101 to read as follows:

16 <u>Sec. 814.0101. EFFECT OF MEMBERSHIP TERMINATION ON</u> 17 <u>BENEFICIARY DESIGNATION. The designation of a beneficiary under</u> 18 <u>this chapter is invalidated when a person terminates membership in</u> 19 <u>the retirement system by withdrawing the person's accumulated</u> 20 <u>contributions. A person who later resumes membership after</u> 21 <u>termination must designate a beneficiary after the resumption of</u> 22 <u>membership for the designation to be effective.</u>

23 SECTION 3. Section 814.401(c), Government Code, is amended 24 to read as follows:

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S.B. No. 1941 1 (c) A benefit is payable under this section only if the member at the time of death was: 2 3 actively employed by the state; 4 (2) receiving workers' compensation benefits for an 5 injury sustained while employed by the state; or 6 (3) on authorized sick leave, excluding leave without 7 pay or leave of absence. 8 SECTION 4. Section 815.403(b), Government Code, is amended to read as follows: 9 Before <u>December 15</u> [November 2] of each even-numbered 10 (b) year, the retirement system shall certify to the Legislative Budget 11 Board and to the budget division of the governor's office for 12 review: 13 (1)an estimate of the amount necessary to pay the 14 15 state's contribution under Subsections (a)(1), (a)(2), (a)(3), and (a)(5) for the following biennium; [and] 16 17 (2) as a separate item, an estimate of the amount required to administer the law enforcement and custodial officer 18 supplemental retirement fund for the following biennium; and 19 20 (3) as required by Section 67, Article XVI, Texas 21 Constitution, for financing benefits on actuarially sound principles, the amount, based on the most recent actuarial 22 valuation, necessary to pay the normal cost and amortize any 23 24 unfunded liability required by the period established under Section 25 811.006. SECTION 5. This Act takes effect September 1, 2015. 26

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
