A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

AN ACT

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- 2 relating to the election of certain county bail bond board members.
- 3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- 4 SECTION 1. Section 1704.0535, Occupations Code, is amended
- 5 to read as follows:

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- 6 Sec. 1704.0535. ELECTION OF CERTAIN BAIL BOND [SURETY]
- 7 BOARD MEMBERS [$\frac{MEMBER}{}$]. (a) The board shall annually conduct a
- 8 secret ballot election to elect the $\underline{members}$ [\underline{member}] of the board
- 9 who serve [serves] as the representative of licensed bail bond
- 10 sureties and the representative of the criminal defense attorneys
- 11 by electing:
- 12 <u>(1)</u> a licensed bail bond surety or agent for a
- 13 corporate surety board member; and
- 14 (2) a criminal defense attorney who is practicing in
- 15 the county.
- 16 (b) Each individual licensed in the county as a bail bond
- 17 surety or agent for a corporate surety is entitled to cast one vote
- 18 for each license held to elect the board member who is a surety or
- 19 <u>agent for a corporate surety</u>.
- 20 <u>(c) Each attorney who has a principal place of business</u>
- 21 located in the county and who is not legally prohibited from
- 22 representing criminal defendants in the county is entitled to cast
- 23 one vote to elect the board member who is a criminal defense
- 24 attorney.

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- SECTION 2. The changes in law made by this Act regarding the election of certain county bail bond board members do not affect the entitlement of a member serving on a board immediately before the effective date of this Act to continue to serve and function as a member of the board for the remainder of the member's term. Those changes in law apply only to a member elected on or after the effective date of this Act.
- 8 SECTION 3. This Act takes effect September 1, 2015.
