5	SECTION 1. The heading to Subchapter S, Chapter 91, Natural
6	Resources Code, is amended to read as follows:

- 9 SECTION 2. Subchapter S, Chapter 91, Natural Resources
- 10 Code, is amended by adding Section 91.852 to read as follows:
- 11 Sec. 91.852. DISCLOSURE OF HYDRAULIC FRACTURING WATER
- 12 <u>VOLUMES</u>. (a) The commission shall require an operator of a well on
- 13 which a hydraulic fracturing treatment is performed to submit to
- 14 the commission:
- 15 (1) the total volume of water used in the hydraulic
- 16 fracturing treatment, with the volume from each source of water
- 17 <u>listed separately;</u>
- 18 (2) the total volumes from all sources of fresh water,
- 19 brackish water, and saline water, listed by type, used in the
- 20 <u>hydraulic fracturing treatment; and</u>
- 21 (3) the total volume of water returning to the surface
- 22 after the hydraulic fracturing treatment.
- 23 <u>(b) The commission shall create and maintain an Internet</u>
- 24 website to collect and make available to the public the information

- 2 SECTION 3. Section 91.852, Natural Resources Code, as added
- 3 by this Act, applies only to a hydraulic fracturing treatment
- 4 performed on a well for which an initial drilling permit is issued
- 5 on or after the date the initial rules adopted by the Railroad
- 6 Commission of Texas under that section take effect. A hydraulic
- 7 fracturing treatment performed on a well for which an initial
- 8 drilling permit is issued before the date the initial rules take
- 9 effect is governed by the law as it existed immediately before the
- 10 effective date of this Act, and that law is continued in effect for
- 11 that purpose.
- 12 SECTION 4. The Railroad Commission of Texas shall adopt
- 13 rules under Section 91.852, Natural Resources Code, as added by
- 14 this Act, not later than January 1, 2016.
- 15 SECTION 5. This Act takes effect September 1, 2015.
