	A BILL TO BE ENTITLED
1	AN ACT
2	relating to a cost-of-living adjustment applicable to certain
3	benefits paid by the Teacher Retirement System of Texas.
4	BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
5	SECTION 1. Subchapter H, Chapter 824, Government Code, is
6	amended by adding Section 824.703 to read as follows:
7	Sec. 824.703. ADDITIONAL COST-OF-LIVING ADJUSTMENT.
8	(a) Notwithstanding Section 824.702, the retirement system shall
9	make a one-time cost-of-living adjustment payable to annuitants
10	receiving a monthly death or retirement benefit annuity, as
11	provided by this section.
12	(b) Subject to Subsections (c) and (d), to be eligible for
13	the adjustment, a person must be, on the effective date of the
14	adjustment and disregarding any forfeiture of benefits under
15	Section 824.601, an annuitant eligible to receive:
16	(1) a standard service or disability retirement
17	annuity payment;
18	(2) an optional service or disability retirement
19	annuity payment as either a retiree or beneficiary;
20	(3) an annuity payment under Section 824.402(a)(3) or
21	<u>(4);</u>
22	(4) an annuity payment under Section 824.502; or
23	(5) an alternate payee annuity payment under Section
24	804.005.

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1	(c) If the annuitant:
2	(1) is a retiree, or is a beneficiary under an optional
3	retirement payment plan, to be eligible for the adjustment under
4	this section:
5	(A) the annuitant must be living on the effective
6	date of the adjustment; and
7	(B) the effective date of the retirement of the
8	member of the Teacher Retirement System of Texas must have been on
9	or after August 31, 2004, and on or before August 31, 2013;
10	(2) is a beneficiary under Section 824.402(a)(3) or
11	(4) or 824.502, to be eligible for the adjustment:
12	(A) the annuitant must be living on the effective
13	date of the adjustment; and
14	(B) the date of death of the member of the
15	retirement system must have been on or after August 31, 2004, and on
16	or before August 31, 2013; or
17	(3) is an alternate payee under Section 804.005, the
18	annuitant is eligible for the adjustment only if the effective date
19	of the election to receive the annuity payment was on or after
20	August 31, 2004, and on or before August 31, 2013.
21	(d) An adjustment made under this section does not apply to
22	payments under:
23	(1) Section 824.203(d), relating to retirees who
24	receive a standard service retirement annuity in an amount fixed by
25	statute;
26	(2) Section 824.304(a), relating to disability
27	retirees with less than 10 years of service credit;

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1	(3) Section 824.304(b)(2), relating to disability
2	retirees who receive a disability annuity in an amount fixed by
3	statute;
4	(4) Section 824.404(a), relating to active member
5	survivor beneficiaries who receive a survivor annuity in an amount
6	fixed by statute;
7	(5) Section 824.501(a), relating to retiree survivor
8	beneficiaries who receive a survivor annuity in an amount fixed by
9	statute; or
10	(6) Section 824.804(b), relating to participants in
11	the deferred retirement option plan with regard to payments from
12	their deferred retirement option plan accounts.
13	(e) An adjustment under this section:
14	(1) must be made beginning with an annuity payable for
15	the month of September 2015; and
16	(2) is limited to the lesser of:
17	(A) an amount equal to three percent of the
18	monthly benefit subject to the increase; or
19	(B) \$100 a month.
20	(f) The board of trustees shall determine the eligibility
21	for and the amount of any adjustment in monthly annuities in
22	accordance with this section.
23	SECTION 2. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives
24	a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as
25	provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this
26	Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this
27	Act takes effect September 1, 2015.
