A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

1 AN ACT

- 2 relating to deferred maintenance for state facilities.
- 3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- 4 SECTION 1. (a) The lieutenant governor and the speaker of
- 5 the house of representatives shall each appoint three members to a
- 6 Joint Oversight Committee on Government Facilities. The members of
- 7 the committee shall elect a chair.
- 8 (b) If this act become effective immediately, the
- 9 lieutenant governor and speaker shall make the appointments not
- 10 later than July 1, 2015. If this act becomes effective September 1,
- 11 2015, the lieutenant governor and speaker shall make the
- 12 appointments not later than September 15, 2015.
- 13 (c) The committee established under this section may meet to
- 14 review deferred maintenance plans and to receive implementation
- 15 updates.
- 16 (d) The committee shall provide a biannual written status
- 17 report to the legislature which includes the amount of money
- 18 appropriated from the deferred maintenance fund, the deferred
- 19 maintenance projects to be completed through appropriations of the
- 20 fund, and the status of ongoing and completed projects.
- (e) The committee established under this section may
- 22 exercise any powers of a joint committee. The cost of operation of
- 23 the committee may be borne in the same manner as the cost of a joint
- 24 committee. The Texas Legislative Council may provide funding for

- 1 the operations of the committees. To the extent not inconsistent
- 2 with this resolution, the joint rules adopted by the 84th
- 3 Legislature for the administration of joint interim legislative
- 4 study committees apply to the committee established under this
- 5 section.
- 6 (f) This section expires January 8, 2021.
- 7 SECTION 2. Chapter 2165, Government Code, is amending by
- 8 adding Subchapter I to read as follows:
- 9 <u>SUBCHAPTER I. DEFERRED MAINTENANCE FUND</u>
- 10 Sec. 2165.401. PURPOSE; INTENT. It is the intent of the
- 11 legislature that state facilities be brought into a better state of
- 12 repair to ensure the safety of employees and visitors, the
- 13 efficiency of building operations and a long-term reduction in
- 14 repair costs by addressing deferred maintenance needs. Funds under
- 15 this subchapter are intended to fund projects to this purpose.
- Sec. 2165.402. DEFINITION. In this subchapter, "fund"
- 17 means the deferred maintenance fund.
- 18 Sec. 2165.403. DEFERRED MAINTENANCE FUND ACCOUNT. (a) The
- 19 deferred maintenance fund is an account in the general revenue
- 20 fund. (b) The fund consists of money credited, appropriated, or
- 21 transferred to the fund at the direction of the legislature.
- 22 SECTION 3. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives
- 23 a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as
- 24 provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this
- 25 Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this
- 26 Act takes effect September 1, 2015.
