- 5 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- 6 SECTION 1. Section 42.023, Local Government Code, is
- 7 amended to read as follows:
- 8 Sec. 42.023. REDUCTION OF EXTRATERRITORIAL JURISDICTION.
- 9 The extraterritorial jurisdiction of a municipality may not be
- 10 reduced unless the governing body of the municipality gives its
- 11 written consent by ordinance or resolution, except:
- 12 (1) in cases of judicial apportionment of overlapping
- 13 extraterritorial jurisdictions under Section 42.901; [or]
- 14 (2) in accordance with an agreement under Section
- 15 42.022(d); or

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- 16 (3) as necessary to comply with Section 42.0235.
- 17 SECTION 2. Subchapter B, Chapter 42, Local Government Code,
- 18 is amended by adding Section 42.0235 to read as follows:
- 19 Sec. 42.0235. LIMITATION ON EXTRATERRITORIAL JURISDICTION
- 20 OF CERTAIN MUNICIPALITIES. (a) Notwithstanding Section 42.021,
- 21 the extraterritorial jurisdiction of a municipality with a
- 22 population of more than 175,000 located in a county that contains an
- 23 international border and borders the Gulf of Mexico terminates two
- 24 miles from the extraterritorial jurisdiction of a neighboring

- 1 municipality if extension of the extraterritorial jurisdiction
- 2 beyond that limit would:
- 3 (1) completely surround the corporate boundaries or
- 4 extraterritorial jurisdiction of the neighboring municipality; and
- 5 (2) limit the growth of the neighboring municipality
- 6 by precluding the expansion of the neighboring municipality's
- 7 extraterritorial jurisdiction.
- 8 (b) A municipality shall release extraterritorial
- 9 jurisdiction as necessary to comply with Subsection (a).
- 10 (c) Notwithstanding any other law, a municipality that owns
- 11 an electric system and that releases extraterritorial jurisdiction
- 12 under Subsection (b) may provide electric service in the released
- 13 area to the same extent that the service would have been provided if
- 14 the municipality had annexed the area.
- 15 SECTION 3. Subchapter B, Chapter 43, Local Government Code,
- 16 is amended by adding Section 43.037 to read as follows:
- 17 Sec. 43.037. PROHIBITION AGAINST ANNEXATION TO SURROUND
- 18 MUNICIPALITY IN CERTAIN COUNTIES. A municipality with a population
- 19 of more than 175,000 located in a county that contains an
- 20 international border and borders the Gulf of Mexico may not annex an
- 21 area that would cause another municipality to be entirely
- 22 surrounded by the corporate limits or extraterritorial
- 23 jurisdiction of the annexing municipality.
- SECTION 4. The change in law made by Section 43.037, Local
- 25 Government Code, as added by this Act, applies to any annexation,
- 26 including an annexation proposed in an annexation plan under
- 27 Section 43.052, Local Government Code, that is not final before the

- 1 effective date of this Act.
- 2 SECTION 5. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives
- 3 a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as
- 4 provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this
- 5 Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this
- 6 Act takes effect September 1, 2015.
