SECTION 1. Section 3858.052, Special District Local Laws Code, is amended to read as follows:

Sec. 3858.052. APPOINTMENT OF DIRECTORS. The board consists of the following directors:

- (1)Position 1: person appointed by the а commissioners court;
- (2) Position 2: appointed the а person bv commissioners court;
- (3) Position 3: a person appointed by the city council;
- (4)a person appointed by Position 4: the citv council; and
- Position 5: (5) a person appointed bу the commissioners court, who must be the individual, the designee of the individual, or the designee of the entity that [who] owns more property in the district than any other individual or entity, except that if the commissioners court is unable to identify a qualified person [qualified for Position 5] who is willing and able to serve, the commissioners court shall appoint to the place a person who is:
  - at least 18 years old; and (A)
  - a resident of this state. (B)

SECTION 2. Subchapter B, Chapter 3858, Special District Local Laws Code, is amended by adding Section 3858.057 to read as follows:

QUALIFICATIONS OF DIRECTORS; PARTICIPATION Sec. 3858.057. (a) Sections 375.063 and 375.072, Local Government IN VOTING. Code, do not apply to a director.

- (b) An official or employee of a public entity may serve on the board. The common law doctrine of incompatibility does not disqualify an official or employee of a public entity from serving as a director.
- (c) A person appointed to serve on the board under this chapter is qualified to serve as a director and participate in all votes pertaining to the business of the district regardless of any
- other statutory provision to the contrary.

  (d) A director may participate in discussion and vote on an 1-57 1-58 action even if the director is an official or employee of a public 1-59 entity and the action relates to assessments on or contracts with 1-60
