BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:

1-20 SECTION 1. Section 6(h), Chapter 1321, Acts of the 77th Legislature, Regular Session, 2001, is repealed. 1-21

1-22 1-23 SECTION 2. (a) Any act or proceeding of the district, including an election, not excepted by this section and taken 1-24 before the effective date of this Act, is validated and confirmed in 1-25 all respects. 1-26

(b) This section does not apply to:

1**-**27 1**-**28 (1) an act, proceeding, director, other official, bond, or other obligation the validity of which or of whom is the 1-29 subject of litigation that is pending on the effective date of this 1-30 Act; or

1-31 an act or proceeding that, under a statute of this (2) 1-32 state or the United States, was a misdemeanor or felony at the time 1-33 the act or proceeding occurred.

1-34 SECTION 3. (a) The legal notice of the intention to introduce this Act, setting forth the general substance of this Act, has been published as provided by law, and the notice and a copy of this Act have been furnished to all persons, agencies, officials, or entities to which they are required to be furnished under Section 59, Article XVI, Texas Constitution, and Chapter 313, 1-35 1-36 1-37 1-38 1-39 1-40 Government Code.
