(1) family law cases and proceedings;

(g) The criminal district attorney is entitled to the same fees prescribed by law for prosecutions in the county court, except 1-27 1-28 1-29 1-30 that in cases assigned under Subsection (a), the criminal district attorney is entitled to the same fees prescribed by law for prosecutions in a district court. SECTION 2. Section 25.1042(a), Government Code, as amended 1-31 1-32

1-33 1-34 by this Act, applies only to an action filed in a district court in 1-35 Harrison County on or after the effective date of this Act.
