RESOLVED, That the senate and house of representatives sit in joint session in the hall of the house of representatives at 2:30 p.m., on Thursday, January 15, 2015, and that the Honorable Rick Perry, Governor of the State of Texas, be, and is hereby, invited to address the Regular Session of the 84th Legislature in joint session at that time; and, be it further

18 RESOLVED, That the senate and house of representatives sit in 19 joint session at 11 a.m. on Tuesday, January 20, 2015, for the 20 inauguration of the governor-elect and lieutenant governor-elect 21 of Texas as determined by the canvass of the votes; and, be it 22 further

23 RESOLVED, That a joint committee, composed of five members of 24 the senate appointed by the lieutenant governor and five members of

1 the house of representatives appointed by the speaker of the house, 2 make arrangements for the joint session and oath-taking ceremony on 3 January 20, 2015; and, be it further
