SENATE CONCURRENT RESOLUTION

1-16 WHEREAS, For more than a decade, the City of Hico has 1-17 celebrated the annual Texas Steak Cookoff, which has become a 1-18 culturally and economically significant regional event; and

1-19 WHEREAS, The popular festival has grown from hosting 15 1-20 cookers in 2004 to over 100 cookers in 2014; the event in 2014 also 1-21 included 15 wineries, 70 vendors, and more than 6,500 guests; the 1-22 impressive growth of Hico's Texas Steak Cookoff prompted coverage 1-23 of the festival by Food Network; and

1-24 WHEREAS, The Hico Economic Development Corporation manages 1-25 the Texas Steak Cookoff; proceeds from the event allow the 1-26 corporation to support organizations such as the Hico Civic Club, 1-27 which focuses on bettering the quality of life in the Hico 1-28 community, and the Memorial Scholarship Foundation, which provides 1-29 scholarships to Hico High School graduates; local businesses also 1-30 benefit from the festival weekend through a boost in retail sales; 1-31 and

1-32 WHEREAS, The designation of the City of Hico as the Steak 1-33 Capital of Texas would honor the city's efforts in establishing and 1-34 annually hosting the Texas Steak Cookoff, a unique festival that 1-35 reflects the importance of the beef industry to this state's 1-36 economy; now, therefore, be it

1-37 RESOLVED, That the 84th Legislature of the State of Texas 1-38 hereby designate Hico as the official Steak Capital of Texas; and, 1-39 be it further

1-40 RESOLVED, That in accordance with the provisions of Section 1-41 391.003(e), Government Code, this designation remain in effect 1-42 until the 10th anniversary of its designation.
