1 SENATE CONCURRENT RESOLUTION

2 WHEREAS, It is a time-honored custom that the portrait of
3 each outgoing Governor of the State of Texas be hung in the Texas
4 Capitol along with those of previous Texas governors; and

5 WHEREAS, The term of Governor Rick Perry, 47th Governor of
6 the State of Texas, has drawn to a close; now, therefore, be it

7 RESOLVED by the Senate of the State of Texas, the House of
8 Representatives concurring, That the 84th Legislature direct that a
9 suitable portrait of Governor Rick Perry be placed in an
10 appropriate location in the Texas Capitol with the portraits of
11 other governors of Texas; the portrait and the charge for such
12 portrait may be made by an artist agreeable with Governor Perry, the
13 lieutenant governor, the Chairman of the Committee on
14 Administration of the Senate, the speaker of the house of
15 representatives, and the Chairman of the House Administration
16 Committee; before the portrait is accepted and placed by the State
17 Preservation Board, it shall have the approval of the lieutenant
18 governor, the Chairman of the Committee on Administration of the
19 Senate, the speaker of the house of representatives, and the
20 Chairman of the House Administration Committee; and, be it further

21 RESOLVED, That a sufficient sum of money be provided through
22 the Committee on Administration of the Senate and the House
23 Administration Committee of the House of Representatives to pay the
24 artist's charges for the portrait.
