## A JOINT RESOLUTION

- 1 proposing a constitutional amendment authorizing the legislature
- 2 to exempt from ad valorem taxation by one or more political
- 3 subdivisions tangible personal property used by the owner of the
- 4 property to manufacture, process, or fabricate tangible personal
- 5 property for ultimate sale.
- 6 BE IT RESOLVED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- 7 SECTION 1. Article VIII, Texas Constitution, is amended by
- 8 adding Section 1-t to read as follows:
- 9 <u>Sec. 1-t.</u> (a) The legislature by general law may exempt
- 10 from ad valorem taxation by one or more political subdivisions
- 11 tangible personal property used by the owner of the property to
- 12 manufacture, process, or fabricate tangible personal property for
- 13 <u>ultimate sale.</u>
- 14 (b) The legislature by general law may provide additional
- 15 eligibility requirements for an exemption authorized by this
- 16 section.
- 17 SECTION 2. This proposed constitutional amendment shall be
- 18 submitted to the voters at an election to be held November 3, 2015.
- 19 The ballot shall be printed to permit voting for or against the
- 20 proposition: "The constitutional amendment authorizing the
- 21 legislature to exempt from ad valorem taxation by one or more
- 22 political subdivisions tangible personal property used by the owner
- 23 of the property to manufacture, process, or fabricate tangible
- 24 personal property for ultimate sale."
