## SENATE JOINT RESOLUTION

1-20 proposing a constitutional amendment authorizing the legislature to permit professional sports team charitable foundations to 1-21 1-22 conduct charitable raffles. 1-23

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:

1-24 SECTION 1. Section 47, Article III, Texas Constitution, is 1-25 amended by amending Subsection (a) and adding Subsection (d-1) to 1-26 read as follows:

1-27 1-28 (a) The Legislature shall pass laws prohibiting lotteries and gift enterprises in this State other than those authorized by 1-29 Subsections (b), (d), (d-1), and (e) of this section.

(d-1) The legislature by general law may permit a professional sports team charitable foundation to conduct charitable raffles under the terms and conditions imposed by general law. The law may authorize the charitable foundation to pay 1-30 1-31 1-32 1-33 with the raffle proceeds reasonable advertising, promotional, and 1-34 1-35 administrative expenses.

SECTION 2. This proposed constitutional amendment shall be 1-36 1-37 submitted to the voters at an election to be held November 3, 2015. The ballot shall be printed to permit voting for or against the proposition: "The constitutional amendment authorizing the 1-38 1-39 legislature to permit professional sports team charitable 1-40 1-41 foundations to conduct charitable raffles."
