## A JOINT RESOLUTION

1 proposing a constitutional amendment mandating the legislature to 2 require candidates for public elective office in this state to 3 undergo drug screening.

4 BE IT RESOLVED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:

5 SECTION 1. Article XVI, Texas Constitution, is amended by 6 adding Section 74 to read as follows:

7 <u>Sec. 74. Notwithstanding any other provision of this</u> 8 <u>constitution, including provisions prescribing exclusive</u> 9 <u>eligibility requirements to hold a public elective office in this</u> 10 <u>state, the legislature shall provide by general law that a</u> 11 <u>candidate for public elective office in this state must submit to a</u> 12 <u>controlled substance use screening assessment.</u>

13 SECTION 2. This proposed constitutional amendment shall be 14 submitted to the voters at an election to be held November 3, 2015. 15 The ballot shall be printed to provide for voting for or against the 16 proposition: "The constitutional amendment mandating the 17 legislature to require candidates for public elective office in 18 this state to undergo drug screening."
